

## The Giving of Communion

*President* Christ is the true bread which has come down from heaven.

*The president will give instructions on how to come forward for communion and on returning to our seats. All are welcome to come to front for the bread and wine or a blessing. If you would like a blessing please keep your arms folded across your chest at you approach the front. We are now able to receive the wine as well as the bread. The president will dip the wafer in the wine before giving it to you. Sanitising stations are available at the front of church to use before receiving.*

*During the distribution the cantor sings and we sing hymn number 51 in the green book.*

## The Prayer after Communion

*President* Let us pray.

God our Father,  
in this night you have made known to us again  
the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ:  
confirm our faith and fix our eyes on him  
until the day dawns  
and Christ the Morning Star rises in our hearts.

**All To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.**

**All We praise and thank you, creator God,**

**Every year we celebrate your coming as Emmanuel.**  
**Every eucharist celebrates his death,**

## The Reading: Hebrews 1. 1 - 4

A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews.

Long ago God spoke to our ancestors in many and various ways by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, through whom he also created the worlds. He is the reflection of God's glory and the exact imprint of God's very being, and he sustains all things by his powerful word. When he had made purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.

## The Gospel Reading: John 1. 1 - 14

**Minister** Alleluia, alleluia.  
The Word became flesh and dwelt among us,  
and we have seen his glory.  
**All Alleluia.**

**Minister** Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John.  
**All Glory to you, O Lord.**

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being. What has come into being in him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light, but he came to testify to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.

## The Notices

*We stand.*

He was in the world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him. But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God, who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the will of man, but of God.

And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth.

### The Creed

*President Let us declare our faith in God,*

*All We believe in one God,  
the Father, the Almighty,  
maker of heaven and earth,

*eternally begotten of the Father,  
God from God, Light from Light,  
true God from true God,  
begotten, not made,*

*of one Being with the Father;  
through him all things were made.  
For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven,  
was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary  
and was made man.*

*For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;  
he suffered death and was buried.*

Look with favour on your people,  
gather us in your loving arms  
and bring us with Mary, Mark, John and all the saints  
to feast at your table in heaven.  
Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
all honour and glory are yours, O loving Father,  
for ever and ever.  
**Amen.**

### The Lord's Prayer

*President Rejoicing in the presence of God here among us,  
as our Saviour taught us, so we pray:*

*All Our Father in heaven,

on earth as in heaven.  
Give us today our daily bread.  
Forgive us our sins  
as we forgive those who sin against us.  
Lead us not into temptation  
but deliver us from evil.  
For the kingdom, the power,  
and the glory are yours  
now and for ever.

### The Breaking of the Bread

*President We break the bread of life,  
and that life is the light of the world.  
All God here among us,  
light in the midst of us,  
bring us to light and life.*

*President* We praise and bless you, loving Father,  
through Jesus Christ, our Lord;  
and as we obey his command,  
send your Holy Spirit,  
that broken bread and wine outpoured  
may be for us the body and blood of your dear Son.

On the night before he died he had supper with his friends  
and, taking bread, he praised you.  
He broke the bread, gave it to them and said:  
Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you;  
do this in remembrance of me.

When supper was ended he took the cup of wine.

Again he praised you, gave it to them and said:  
Drink this, all of you;

this is my blood of the new covenant,  
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.  
Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.

So, Father, we remember all that Jesus did,  
in him we plead with confidence his sacrifice  
made once for all upon the cross.

Bringing before you the bread of life and cup of salvation,  
we proclaim his death and resurrection  
until he comes in glory.

*Minister* Great is the mystery of faith:

Cantor Rising you restored our life  
**All Rising you restored our life**  
Cantor Lord Jesus come  
**All Lord Jesus come**

*President* Lord of all life,  
help us to work together for that day  
when your kingdom comes  
and justice and mercy will be seen in all the earth.

On the third day he rose again  
in accordance with the Scriptures;  
he ascended into heaven,  
and is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead,  
and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.  
We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.

## The Liturgy of the Sacrament

### The Eucharistic Prayer

*President This holy night the angels sang,  
'Glory to God in the highest heaven,  
and on earth peace to all in whom he delights.'*

*President The peace of the Lord be always with you  
All and also with you.*

*Minister Let us offer one another a sign of peace.*

*We remain in our seats, sharing the peace through waves to those  
around us.*

### The Offertory Hymn

*We stand and we sing hymn number 253 from the green book as  
gifts of bread and wine are brought to the front of church and the  
altar is prepared.*

*President The Lord is here.  
All His Spirit is with us.*

*President Lift up your hearts.  
All We lift them to the Lord.*

*President Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
All It is right to give thanks and praise.*

*President All glory and honour be yours always and everywhere,  
mighty creator, ever-living God.*

*We give you thanks and praise for your Son,  
our Saviour Jesus Christ,  
who for love of our fallen race humbled himself,  
and on this night was born of the Virgin Mary  
by the power of your Spirit,  
and lived as one of us.*

*In this mystery of the Word made flesh  
you have caused his light to shine in our hearts,  
to give knowledge of your glory in the face of Jesus Christ.  
In him we see our God made visible  
and so are caught up in the love of the God we cannot see.  
Therefore with all the angels of heaven  
we lift our voices to proclaim the glory of your name  
and sing our joyful hymn of praise:*
